CREATION OF A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) TO CREATE A COMMON STAMP AND STICKER FOR THE SUBIC-CLARK ZONE AUTHORITIES

WHEREAS the Subic-Clark Corridor Zone Authorities separately design and utilize different stamps in the processing of the official documents of their locators, investors and workers;

WHEREAS, the Zone Authorities separately design and produce stickers for qualified vehicles transiting their territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS following the meeting held at the SCAD office last March 27 on the preparation of the Revised Rules and Procedures on the Processing and Issuance of Permits and Visas of Foreign Nationals, the representatives of SBMA, CDC and SCAD have realized the advantage and convenience of coming up with a uniform design for their official stamps and stickers;

WHEREAS the adoption of a reliable, creative and appropriate stamp and sticker will facilitate the ease of doing business and the easy transportation of goods and passengers going in and from the territorial jurisdictions of the Zones;

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

- I. A Technical Working Group (TWG) is hereby created to propose and draft guidelines for the use and design of a common stamp to be used by the Zone Authorities in the processing and/or endorsement of papers and documents as well as design a common sticker for the use of vehicles within the Subic-Clark Corridor.

A. Composition – The TWG shall be, composed of the following members:

1. One representative from the Bases Conversion and Development Authority
2. One representative from the Clark Development Corporation
3. One representative from the Clark International Airport Corporation
4. One Representative from the Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority
5. One representative from the SCAD

The SCAD Secretariat shall provide staff support services, including reporting, scheduling of activities, meeting arrangements and general coordination.

The members shall choose from among them the representative to act as Chairman of the TWG.

B. Functions

1. Formulate guidelines, for approval of the Council, implementing the design and use of the common stamp and sticker;
2. Select a suitable design, for approval of the Council that will be representative of the Corridor and the identities of the participating Zone Authorities;
3. Identify and incorporate appropriate security features, including technical and or regulatory aspects, into the selected design;
4. Perform such other functions as it may hereafter be authorized.

C. The expenses necessary to perform the functions herein shall be defrayed thru SCAD funds.

D. The TWG shall complete its purpose within three (3) weeks from the time of its constitution.
